JUDGING

THE NATAS JUDGING PROCEDURE

The purpose of the Awards is to provide incentives for continuing outstanding individual and production achievements within our industry and to focus public attention upon the multi-talented individuals who comprise the industry. Entries in the Lone Star Regional EMMY® Awards do not compete against other. They are judged against a standard of excellence; as a result,

there can be one award, more than one award, or no award in each category.

Panels of peers in each judging chapter scored each entry on content, creativity, and execution. There are no winners or losers here tonight - only those who continue to make our markets representative of the best work in the country!

SPANISH LANGUAGE NON-COMPETITIVE JUDGING

English and Spanish entries in the Lone Star EMMY® Awards are judged independently, and have never competed against each other. By vote of the NATAS Board of Trustees (October, 2002), every Spanish-language entry that is submitted for EMMY® consideration must be judged by a qualified panel of Spanish-speaking, peer judges.

Here is the NATAS Rule as stated in the Regional EMMY® Award Standard Clauses (“National Rules”):

LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH: Spanish-language entries may be entered and will be judged by a panel of Spanish-speaking, peer judges in a separate contest from English language. The scores produced by these two panels are not combined; instead the scores are interpreted separately for final “cut-off” evaluation.

The Lone Star EMMY® Chapter announces English and Spanish Awards during the same event. Each year, The Lone Star EMMY® Chapter has published the Regional EMMY® Awards Standard Clauses (“National Rules”) in their entirety on the Chapter’s website, lonestaremmy.org

LONE STAR CHAPTER JUDGING POLICY

The success of the EMMY® Awards process depends on the willingness of qualified professionals to serve as judges.

By entering, you agree to serve as a judge when asked, and that judging must occur during calendar year of your entry.

- Entrants are required to judge as many categories as entered or up to 3 times.
- If you enter the EMMY® Awards you are required to judge every 12 months.
- If entrant does not judge within the 12 months, the penalty fee is \$50 per person/per entry.

There are typically 7-9 opportunities to judge other chapters’ entries during the year (we call them Trades) and all entrants are notified via email. You can expect to see these judging notices regularly through the year beginning in December of each year and they run until September of the following year.

The time commitment for judging? 30 minutes to 2 hours, depending on the category; judging can be done anywhere you have a computer; it’s easy and all online. There is no limit to the amount of judging you can do, as long as you’re qualified to judge the categories you choose. You don’t have to be a member or entrant to judge.

HISTORY OF THE EMMY STATUETTE

The EMMY® statuette has a rich history, from its design to its name, and here are some of the details:

DESIGN

Television engineer Louis McManus designed the statuette in 1948, using his wife as the model for the winged woman. The Academy rejected 47 other proposals before choosing McManus's design.

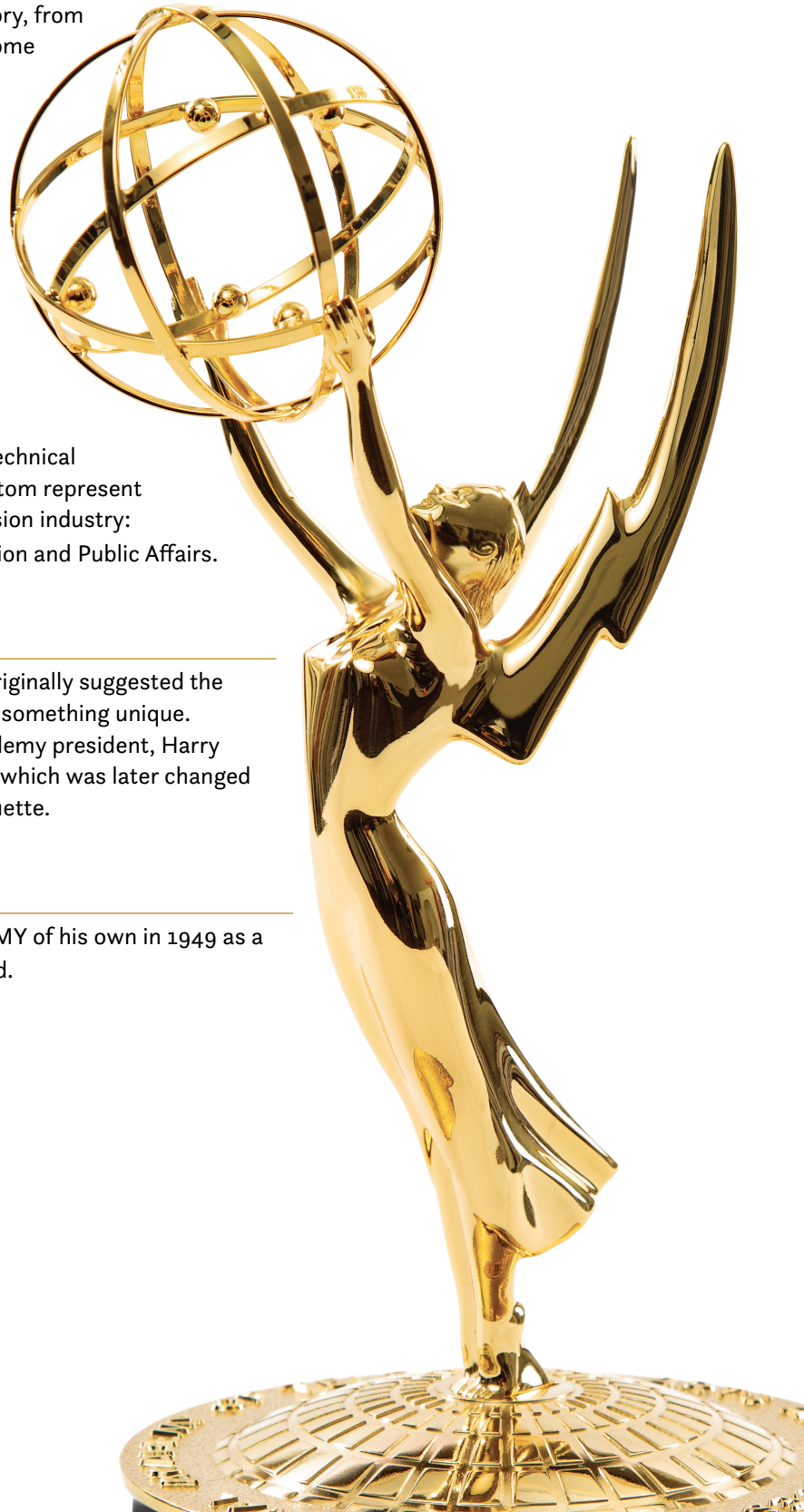
The winged woman holding the atom symbolizes television's creative and technical aspects. The five spheres inside the atom represent the five major categories in the television industry: Entertainment, News, Sports, Education and Public Affairs.

NAME

The Academy founder, Syd Cassyd, originally suggested the name "Ike," but the members wanted something unique. Television engineer and the third Academy president, Harry Lubcke, suggested the name "Immy," which was later changed to "EMMY" to match the female statuette.

PRESENTATION

McManus was presented with an EMMY of his own in 1949 as a special tribute for designing the award.





REGIONAL EMMY® INFORMATION & USAGE RIGHTS

USE OF REGIONAL EMMY NAME AND STATUETTE IN ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY

COMMEMORATIVE STATUETTES

As a courtesy, stations, studios, production companies and other Chapter-approved organizations may order a commemorative statuette for public display at their place of business. The statuette is engraved the same as the original Emmy® Award, with the word “commemorative” added. Neither the organization’s name nor any other special wording may be engraved in place of where the individual’s name and position would usually appear. Commemorative Emmy® statuettes cannot be ordered for individuals.

PROMOTION

All publicity, advertising or any written reference undertaken by nominees and award recipients to the Emmy® Awards, must clearly state that the awarded achievement is for a Regional Emmy® Award. The word “Regional” must appear in these instances. The recipient of a nomination or an Emmy® Award may refer in advertising and publicity to the fact that they have been honored only for one year after the recognition was bestowed. They may use a replica of the Emmy® statuette in such advertising. Individuals who significantly contributed to the production or craft but were not honored with a statuette cannot specifically advertise they are an Emmy® award recipient. They can only state they worked on the recognized program.

RULES FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE EMMY® STATUETTE

The Emmy® statuette is the property of and all rights are reserved by The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (NATAS) and the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences (Television Academy). The Emmy® statuette may not be reproduced or used in any commercial manner unless otherwise permitted by NATAS, it being understood that possession of the same is solely for the benefit of the recipient and the recipient’s heirs or successors in interest. If a recipient or the recipient’s heir or successor in interest proposes to sell, loan, donate or otherwise dispose of the Emmy® statuette, such persons shall be obligated to return the statuette to The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences which will retain the same in storage in memory of the recipient.

A ® registration mark and the appropriate copyright notice: © NATAS/Television Academy must accompany any portrayal of the Emmy® statuette or moniker.

KDFW

Now celebrating her 50th year in broadcasting, Clarice Tinsley has been bringing North Texas the news on KDFW at 10pm for 47 years. Along the way, she's earned numerous awards, and the respect and trust of generations.

Most notably, Clarice won the George Foster Peabody Award for her investigation into the Dallas emergency response system. Her research and reporting resulted in new protocols, new training and countless lives saved.

Whether heading up the Mayor's Smart Summer Reading Program, as she has since 2008 or devoting time and talent to the Susan G. Komen Foundation, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, MLK Jr. Oratory Competition, community involvement is in Ms. Tinsley's DNA.

In January 2025 Clarice received The Trailblazer Award from the City of Dallas, Office of Community Care at the 43rd annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship and Award Gala. Clarice was inducted into the 2020 National Association of Black Journalists Hall of Fame. In April 2017, the State Fair of Texas announced the creation of the Clarice Tinsley Journalism Scholarship. This educational opportunity is given to a college recipient who is studying to become a broadcast or print journalist.

In May 2016, the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters was bestowed upon Clarice, as she was hooded in the crimson and gold colors of Austin College in Sherman, Texas.

In addition to the George Foster Peabody Award, Clarice has earned a DuPont- Columbia Citation, three Dallas Press Club Katie Awards, three Lone Star EMMYS, Best Investigative Reporting from Texas Associated Press, the Texas Headliner Award for Investigative Reporting, the Journalistic Award for Excellence from the American College of Emergency Physicians and First Place from the Texas Public Health Association.

Clarice shares her home with her husband, Sales Executive Stephen Giles, her mother, retired educator Janet Tinsley, and their cat, Legacy.

Deborah Ferguson co-anchors NBC 5 Today weekday mornings from 5 a.m. to 7 a.m. She joined the station in 1991 after starting her journalism career as a reporter/anchor for WBAP Radio.

Professional recognition through the years includes a regional Edward R. Murrow Award, a Gracie Award for Outstanding Anchor – News presented by American Women in Radio and Television and other honors from the American Women in Communications, the Association for Women Journalists, the American Cancer Society, the American Heart Association, the Texas Medical Association, the Dallas Press Club, and the Lone Star EMMY Chapter.

Deborah is an in-demand emcee for nonprofit organizations and charitable events, especially those focused on empowering girls through education, encouraging future journalists and spotlighting women who lead.

She co-founded the Foundation for the Young Women’s Leadership Academy of Fort Worth which supports YWLA, the first all-girls school in the Fort Worth ISD.

She graduated from Texas Christian University with a degree in broadcast journalism which set her on the path to achieve her lifelong dream of becoming a reporter. While in college, she interned at NBC 5 and joined the staff just a few years later.

Deborah is married to Texas Radio Hall of Fame inductee Steve Lamb.

Angel has been a reporter and news anchor for over 36 years, including the past 20 in North Texas with Univision Noticias 23. Angel has remained at the forefront of change and technology throughout his career, continually adapting to connect with new generations of journalists and audiences. While many veteran journalists have resisted innovation, Angel has embraced it—constantly exploring new ways better to deliver the news beyond the traditional anchor desk and engage Spanish-speaking viewers. For the past two decades, while anchoring the 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. newscasts Monday through Friday, he also maintained a strong presence in the community, staying closely connected with people on the streets.

Angel has worked as a news writer, producer, reporter, news manager, and news anchor throughout my career. Since May 2005, he has been a news anchor and reporter for Univision Channel 23 in Dallas, where he also lead the team behind *Al Punto DFW*, a political news magazine program.

Angel is a multiple Lone Star Emmy Award winner, including the 2024 EMMY for Outstanding Achievement as a News Anchor and the 2023 Texas Broadcast News Award for Best News Anchor.

His journalism career began in 1989 at Channel 11 in Mexico City. At the same time, he anchored the radio newscast *Entorno on Stereorey*, part of the MVS Radio network. In 1991, he joined MVS Televisión and MVS Radio, where he worked as a news anchor, reporter, and news coordinator for programs such as *Para Usted*, *Para Empezar*, and *Don Dinero*. During that time, he had the opportunity to cover key moments in Mexican and North Texas history.

Angel was also a founding member of *Imagen Multimedia*, now one of Mexico's largest national radio and television networks, where he worked as a news anchor and reporter. Additionally, he served as anchor and director for two shows on the online TV platform *TeVe de Mente: Ángel Pedrero Entrevista a...* and *De Mente en Mente*.

His work as a journalist extends beyond electronic media. Angel has contributed to several magazines and a newspaper, including *Entrepreneur*, *Gran Evento*, *Economía Nacional*, and *Summa*.

Angel holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), the largest university in the country. He is married and the proud father of two wonderful daughters.

RAUL RANGEL KXAS (POSTHUMOUS)



“All editors are unsung heroes, but Raul stands out.”

The family, friends and co-workers who knew and loved Raul Rangel are excited to see his lifetime of hard work and uncompromising standards honored by the Lone Star Emmy Chapter with entry into the Silver Circle. Raul worked at KXAS as an editor for more than 20 years. His journalism career began in 1982 and included stops in Beaumont, Corpus Christi, Austin, San Antonio and ultimately Dallas-Fort Worth. Raul worked tirelessly to make sure every frame of video he edited helped further the story. He loved being in the field working with teams of reporters and photojournalists to make the biggest moments in North Texas history feel personal to the viewers of NBC-5. One of the field assignments Raul loved the most was his trip to the Vatican for the Papal Conclave. Raul hated wallpaper-video and had little patience with a script that ignored the best moments captured by a photographer. Raul lost his battle with ALS earlier this year, a battle he waged for 8 years. He will forever be remembered as one of the unsung heroes who championed good stories, fought for his family and cherished the friends who knew him best.

MARK SCIRTO

KLTV



Mark Scirto first joined KLTV in Tyler, TX in 1987 as the original Meteorologist for “Daybreak”, the station’s first morning newscast. Mark remained with that role for four years, before moving to KPLC-TV in Lake Charles, LA where he served as Chief Meteorologist before coming back to KLTV as Chief Meteorologist on April 4, 1994.

Mark is one of the most recognized and trusted weather authorities in East Texas. With a broadcasting career spanning over three decades, Mark became a household name, known for his expertise, reliability, and genuine concern for the safety of his viewers.

It was not uncommon for Mark to take a break during continuous tornado coverage to call, or directly address, his family in the path of the storm.

Mark began his journey in meteorology after earning his degree in the field in 1982 from the University of St. Thomas in Houston. From 1980 to 1987 Mark worked in Houston as a forecaster for a private company that served oil rigs and refineries all over the world. He also forecasted weather for several radio stations in Houston. Mark has guided East Texans through everything from sunny days to the region’s most severe storms.

Throughout his career, Mark has covered countless significant weather events, including tornado outbreaks, hurricanes, ice storms, and floods. His calm demeanor and clear explanations during severe weather have helped countless families stay safe and informed. Mark’s dedication to his craft has earned him several awards and recognitions, both from professional meteorological organizations and the East Texas community.

Beyond the weather center, Mark has always been actively involved in community outreach. Each year he toured East Texas schools for his weather safety presentation “Project Tornado”, when technology advanced, he took the program live online for an interactive talkback and presentation.

Mark’s efforts helped to inspire the next generation of weather enthusiasts. He is also a member of the American Meteorological Society and holds their Seal of Approval, a mark of excellence in broadcast meteorology.

Mark’s commitment to East Texas goes beyond forecasting. He is known for his approachable personality, willingness to answer viewers’ questions, and his deep roots in the community. Whether he’s tracking a storm or supporting local causes, Mark Scirto’s dedication and professionalism have made him a beloved figure in East Texas broadcasting.

Each December Mark worked to be the face of the station’s “Coats for Kids” project, as well as hearing from hundreds of children each December as Mark donned his trademark beard and red costume in order to become “Santa Scirto”.

On a personal note, Mark is a fishing fanatic. He also loves hockey, golf, and guitar as well as singing at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Tyler. Mark has four children, Katherine, Mark, Anthony, and Hannah, and 17 grandchildren. Beth, his wife of 40 years, is retired from teaching theology to thousands and thousands of young people in the Catholic School Systems in Houston, Lake Charles, and Tyler.

ANA MARIA VARGAS

KUVN



Originally from Mexico City, Ana María Vargas is a journalist with more than 35 years of experience anchoring radio and television newscasts.

Born, raised, and educated in Mexico City, Ana María earned her Bachelor's degree in Communication Sciences and Techniques, specializing in Television.

In 1987, her first works on television included participating in the very first chapter of Mexican television history — a special production by Televisa.

In 1988, Ana María began her journalistic career as a news announcer at Radio Chapultepec in Mexico City. Later that year, she joined Televisa as a researcher and reporter for the television programs *Contrapunto* and *Mundo de Dinero*, under the leadership of Abraham Zabludovsky. Televisa News Career (1988–2000) Ana María served as a news anchor for *24 Horas de la Tarde*, the evening edition of the iconic Mexican newscast *24 Horas*, working closely with Zabludovsky, one of Mexico's most influential journalists. She later took charge of coordinating, producing, and anchoring the weekend edition, *24 Horas: Edición de Fin de Semana*, broadcast every Saturday night through Sunday midnight. ECO – Televisa's Global News Network (1988–2001)

From 1988 to 2001, Ana María was one of the lead anchors of "ECO", Televisa's pioneering 24-hour Spanish-language news network, which broadcast continuously around the world. ECO first aired on September 1, 1988, and Ana María Vargas was among its founding anchors, remaining on air until the network concluded its historic global mission in April 2001. Throughout her years at ECO, she also served as anchor, coordinator, and producer of special programs focused on environmental issues, science, and technology, reaching both national and international audiences.

In 2006, Ana María became the news anchor and director of *Al Instante*, a morning newscast on Radio Capital in Mexico City.

Since 2008, Ana María has been one of the main anchors of Univision 23 (KUVN) in Dallas–Fort Worth, Texas, leading the 5 PM and 10 PM newscasts, Monday through Friday.

For over a decade, she has also hosted and directed the weekly community program *Contigo en la Comunidad*, which features interviews with experts, authorities, and community leaders who share valuable information, opportunities, and mostly free resources with the public.

A Witness to History Throughout her distinguished career, Ana María Vargas has covered some of the most significant events in modern history, including the end of the Cold War, the fall of the Berlin Wall, the dissolution of the Soviet Union, the Gulf War, the end of apartheid in South Africa, and the Kosovo conflict, among many other historic milestones.

Since moving to Texas nearly 18 years ago, Ana María has dedicated every broadcast to her community with passion, integrity, and professionalism, delivering vital information that impacts people's daily lives. Her outstanding work has earned her nine Lone Star Emmy Awards.

She has been married to Javier Giribet for 34 years, has a son Javier and Gady, a four-year-old grandson.

Ana María Vargas is a proud Mexican and Latina journalist who, for more than three decades, has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to truth, transparency, and the well-being of her audience.

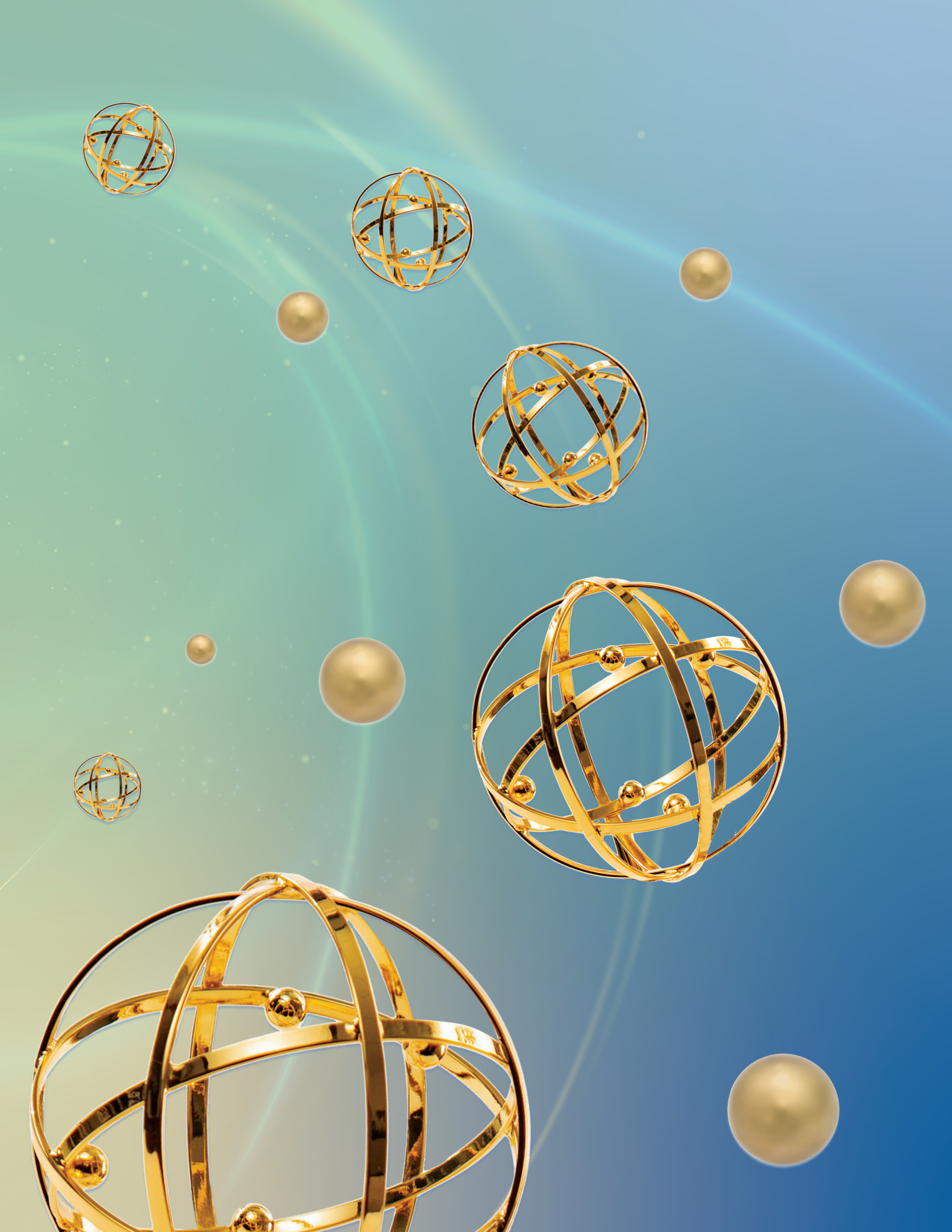

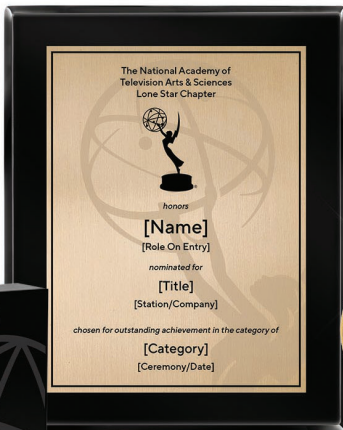
